Thank you for your continued support of our ongoing efforts to provide our members, residents and guests a safe environment and as many services and products as state and federal legislation and executive orders allow us. Having said that, there are decisions that will have to be made that are not clearly addressed in these documents.

Late yesterday we made the decision to close the driving range during this 30 day stay at home order. Our team members were becoming increasingly concerned about handling the driving range equipment, baskets and balls and possible contamination. Additionally, there was a social distancing challenge relative to the spacing of the mats and groups of individuals congregating together while waiting for an available station. This action is consistent with actions taken by other clubs in our area.

To take advantage of this down time on the driving range, we will do some much needed maintenance including aeration, top dressing and grading.

Given the fact that the driving range is closed, please limit your arrival time at the course to just 10 -15 minutes prior to your round to avoid groups of golfers congregating within close proximity of each other.

The putting green and chipping area remain open for you to use with your own balls.

Additionally, we are asking that golf groups that have been gathering after golf to socialize, refrain from doing so during this 30 day period. While some of these groups may start out

small and have only 4 -6 people, we continue to see these groups growing in number as others drive by and stop to socialize.

Our goal is and has always been to provide our members and guests with the most outstanding service. But these are extraordinary times and our staff that are working on the front lines to keep these services going for you are concerned for their health and that of their families.

The risk may seem low to those of you who are observing from afar but our staff are taking their responsibility very seriously and to them the risk is very real.

I ask you to show your support by accepting these restrictions for a limited time in a manner that is commensurate with the risk our team members are taking for you.
