Dear Homeowners, Residents & Members,

It has been nice to see so many members and residents out enjoying the great weather in Florida during the Coronavirus crisis. Unfortunately, we are also seeing an increase in potentially dangerous activities.

We have previously communicated the danger that walking in the road poses and now we must let you know about the dangerous activity that we are seeing on the golf course and on Powerline Road.

GOLF CART PATHS

The number of walkers and bikers on the golf cart paths is growing exponentially. Many individuals are out before play starts when our staff is on the course performing daily maintenance. But we are also seeing walkers and riders during active play which is dangerous and disruptive. Staff members and golfers are not expecting to see walkers or bike riders on the course which could result in a dangerous accident.

In addition to the overall increase of activity, we are seeing a dramatic jump in the number of people walking dogs on the golf course and on Powerline Road both on and off leashes. This has resulted in a dramatic increase in dog waste and dog waste bags on the ground and in the golf course trash cans which are only to be used for food and paper trash. This is a health safety issue for our staff and for players on the course. Unleashed dogs on

Powerline Road are particularly dangerous as we use large equipment to move sand, gravel and dirt which is stored in that area. It is virtually impossible to see a dog or individual moving behind you when driving one of those large pieces of equipment.

Please remember that the use of the golf cart paths for any use other than for players ACTIVELY engaged in a round of golf is PROHIBITED. This includes walking, jogging, bike riding and driving your golf cart to and from home.

Thank you for your help to keep you and our staff safe on the golf course.
